Purpose:

Objectives:

Participants will be able to demonstrate increased knowledge and skills around problematic substance use in pregnancy (PSUP), including:

- Screening and identification of women with PSUP
- Management and/or referral of women with PSUP
- Screening and assessment of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)
